All of your information, assignments, and materials will be posted in your Google Classroom. To join your classrooms, use your Flushingschools account.

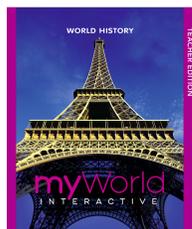
