Age Requirement → 14 years + 8 months

Students who wish to take Driver Education this summer MUST be:

14 years 8 months by June 8
(Turning 15 years old by Oct. 8)

Driver Education Program Dates for 2021

Driver Education will be offered **June 8 - July 1, 2021**

- June 8 & 9 will be 2 hours of classroom only after school
 - (3-5 pm)
- Students are required to be in attendance for every class/date to meet the minimum requirement set by the state.



Cost

The cost for Driver Education at Flushing High School is
\$360

- This includes ALL classroom, range, and Behind the Wheel instruction for BOTH Driver's Ed Segment 1 and 2.



Class Schedule

- All classes and the driving range will take place at Flushing High School
- BTW - a series of local roads and traffic situations to ensure student is safe to enter the roadways with a permit and accompanied by their parents/guardians.



Hours Required

- **Class - 24 hours** (two hours per day)
 - Four hours of class is required before any 'driving' is allowed (June 8 and 9)
 - Usually Mon-Friday
- **Combination of Range and BTW - 12 hours**
 - (students will alternate the two every other day)

Class - Instruction Schedule



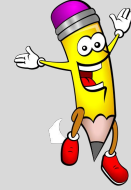
- Class time/sections and driving groups will be assigned prior to June and we will try to accommodate requests for those who might be carpooling with other students, etc...
- The BTW/Range class time will likely happen either before or after your student's classroom instruction.
 - So expect your student to be at the high school up to 4 to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours per day during the program.

Covid Safety Measures - **Safety First**



- We will be closely following the recommendations from the Genesee County Health Department pertaining to class size and social distancing of students.
- ALL instructors and students will be **REQUIRED** to wear a mask during the program both in the classroom and BTW
- There will also be additional safety measures addressed for the BTW instruction (disinfect interior of car, etc...)

Classroom Requirements



- Students will be given daily homework and it is expected to be finished prior to coming to the following class.
- Students will receive instruction via instructor, textbook, and DE slides and videos.
- There will also be teacher led instruction for the Range and BTW

Course Completion Requirements

- At the end of the session, students will take the Michigan State Driver Education Segment One Test.
- After completing all classwork, the driving skills test, and passing the state test, students will earn a Segment 1 Certificate of Completion.

Student Permits



- After completion of the classroom and driving requirements, there will be a parent/student meeting (either in person or via Zoom) to discuss restrictions, laws for new drivers, etc...
 - This meeting will tentatively take place **June 29 at 6:00 pm** **either in person or via Zoom.**
 - **More information will be forthcoming**
 - The student will take the certificate to the Secretary of State to get his/her Learner's Permit.

Sign-up

- Students can pick up a copy of the DE application in the FHS Counseling Office (or at the middle school for any 8th grader who meets the age requirement) during normal school hours
- OR you can print one from the FHS Driver's Education webpage
- Students will need to bring the completed forms and payment to the counseling office to secure a spot for this summer's program.*

* The program's cost is refundable if a drop/cancellation happens due to Covid19 concerns or new directives from the Governor/Health Dept.

- There will be information posted on the FHS web page with updated information as the summer date gets closer.
