


HOW MUCH WILL IT COST ME?

This will be a 0 (zero) mill increase over the current tax rate which is only possible due to the rapidly increasing property values in our district. We currently levy 3.18 mills to retire our existing debt, and this bond initiative is seeking to continue that 3.18 tax rate.

0 MILL TAX INCREASE* \$23,550,000 BOND

BALLOT LANGUAGE

Shall the Flushing Community Schools, County of Genesee, State of Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-Three Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$23,550,000) Dollars and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds, in one or more series, to pay the cost of the following projects to create a modern learning environment for students and for health, safety, security, energy conservation and other purposes:

- Remodeling, equipping, re-equipping, furnishing, re-furnishing school buildings, athletic fields, playgrounds and other facilities;
- Acquiring and installing technology equipment and technology infrastructure in school buildings and other facilities;
- Erecting facilities and structures at the High School athletic fields; and
- Preparing, developing and improving sites at school buildings, athletic fields, playgrounds and other facilities?

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- · Replace exterior doors for added security
- Upgrade door security system
- · Add more security cameras in buildings

- Replace aging instructional technology in classrooms

- Selective playground equipment


PERFORMING ARTS/AUDITORIUM UPDATES

 - Restrooms and concessions at entrance
 - · Synthetic turf field
 - Running track
 - Track and field event space
 - · Home team room, officials room
 - · Visitor team building
- · Resurface tennis courts
- Remodel baseball and softball fields, including new press boxes, backstops, dugouts and bleachers
- New asphalt paving at baseball/tennis parking lot and drive
- Resurface part of northeast parking lot
