*Both groups (AM & PM) will attend at the scheduled date/time. Groups will be divided into separate rooms to allow for distancing.

*Specials will still be held as scheduled on M-Step testing dates with the exception of **6th grade**:

- PE will post an asynchronous lesson for 6th grade students.
- Science will hold their 6th grade live lesson at 3:15 p.m. instead of 11:15 a.m.

All on-line students will be tested beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday mornings. Students may start arriving to schools at 8:50 a.m. **Transportation is available, if requested by filling out this survey: <https://bit.ly/3tVuu8z>.**

The schedule above allows for students to test in the mornings, when they're typically the most refreshed, students will be able attend their live specials in the afternoons, and they will be the only students in the buildings, so safety and distancing is able to be implemented. Each grade level is assigned to test at a different elementary school so our principals and lab managers are able to offer testing support as needed. Please pay attention to which school your child(ren) is assigned for testing.
